

## REFEREE APPLICATION

There will be two (2) days of competition for this event. Those referees that can officiate both competition days will be given preference. Referees shall be selected by the NCTA Referee Chairperson. Referees will receive hotel accommodations for 3 nights (double occupancy only), breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Friday and Saturday. Referees that are selected will be responsible for their own round-trip airfare and hotel incidentals. Any referee who makes their own hotel accommodations will be responsible for the entire cost of the room. The tournament director will provide transportation to and from the airport and the venue. Referee attire will be black suit, white shirt, and red tie. When and if you are selected, you will need to provide airline arrival and departure information into the designated airport ONLY (either SFO "San Francisco" or SJC "San Jose") in order for the tournament director and the NCTA to plan accordingly. There will be a WTF poomsae seminar held in the morning of Friday, April 25<sup>th</sup>.

## **NATIONAL COLLEGIATE TAEKWONDO ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT**

The following outline is the Code of Conduct for the NCTA. The Code is for all athletes, coaches, tournament committee, referees and staff members to fully abide by when participating in any and all NCTA event(s). Failure to comply with the following guidelines can result in the removal from an event, dismissal from future NCTA events, and/or the complete suspension from participation as a competitor, coach or staff member in future NCTA events.

One will act in a manner, consistent with the spirit of fair play and responsible conduct.

One will acknowledge, respect and adhere to the authority of NCTA-appointed event staff, tournament staff, and team leader(s) if necessary.

One will fully comply with the NCTA, USA Taekwondo, the United States Olympic Committee (USOC), and the World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) uniform requirement.

One will maintain an appropriate level of fitness to promote optimal athletic performance.

One will refrain from the excessive use of performance-limiting drugs, including, but not limited to, tobacco and alcohol.

One will refrain from using any substance on the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code, as enforced by USADA.

One will abide by the policies and rules established by the NCTA, USA Taekwondo, the USOC and the World Taekwondo Federation.

One will respect others, including coaches, competitors, officials, and spectators.

One will not engage in, nor tolerate, any form of verbal, physical or sexual abuse.

One will respect the property of others.

One will refrain from illegal or inappropriate behavior that would deter from a positive image of oneself and the NCTA.

One will maintain a positive attitude and act in a way that will bring honor to oneself, the staff, the sport of Taekwondo, the NCTA, and the United States of America.

One will remember that I am an ambassador of the NCTA, my country and the Olympic movement.

The National Collegiate Taekwondo Association recognizes that this Code does not establish a comprehensive set of rules that prescribes every aspect of appropriate behavior.
